The 2022 United Nations Climate Change Conference or Conference of the Parties of the UNFCCC, more commonly referred to as COP27, was the 27th United Nations Climate Change Conference.

It took place under the presidency of Egyptian Government, with more than 90 heads of state and an estimated 35,000 representatives, or delegates, of 190 countries attending. It was the first climate summit held in Africa since 2016.

It is the World's largest United Nations Climate Change Conference.

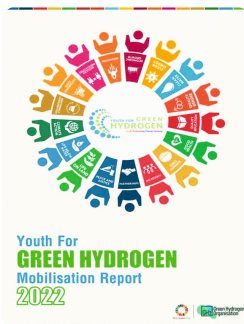

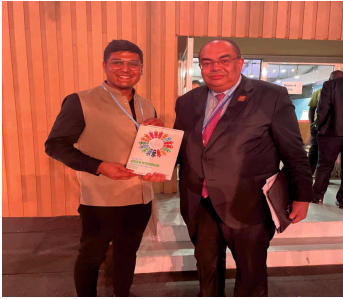

“It takes longer to get the permit to establish an offshore wind plant than to build it and get it running,” Mads Nipper CEO of wind maker Ørsted.

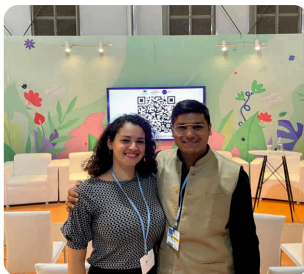
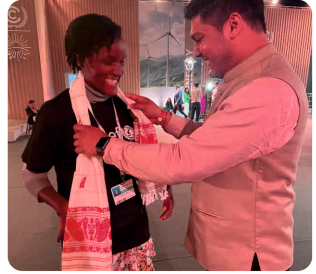
PATHWAYS TO A CLIMATE-FRIENDLY AND FAIR GREEN HYDROGEN ECONOMY

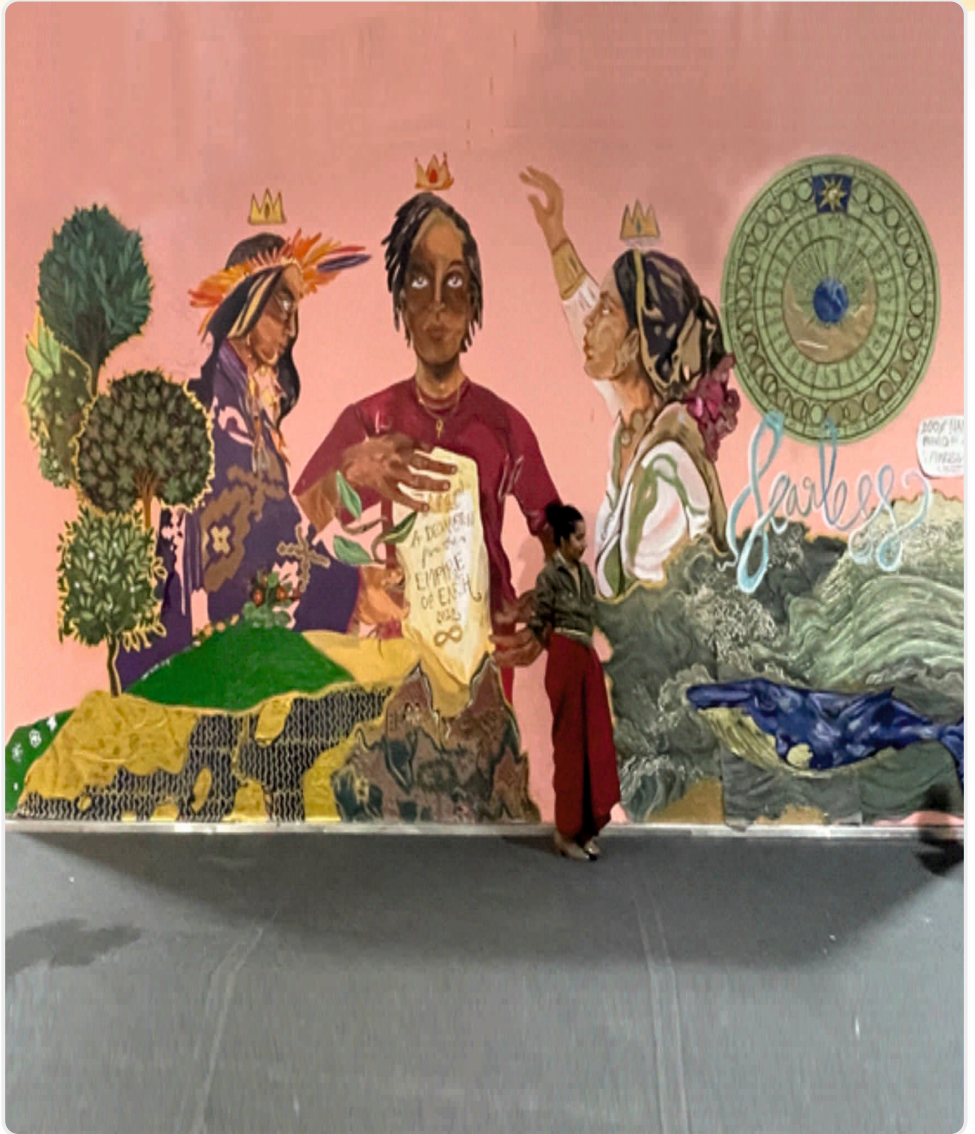
