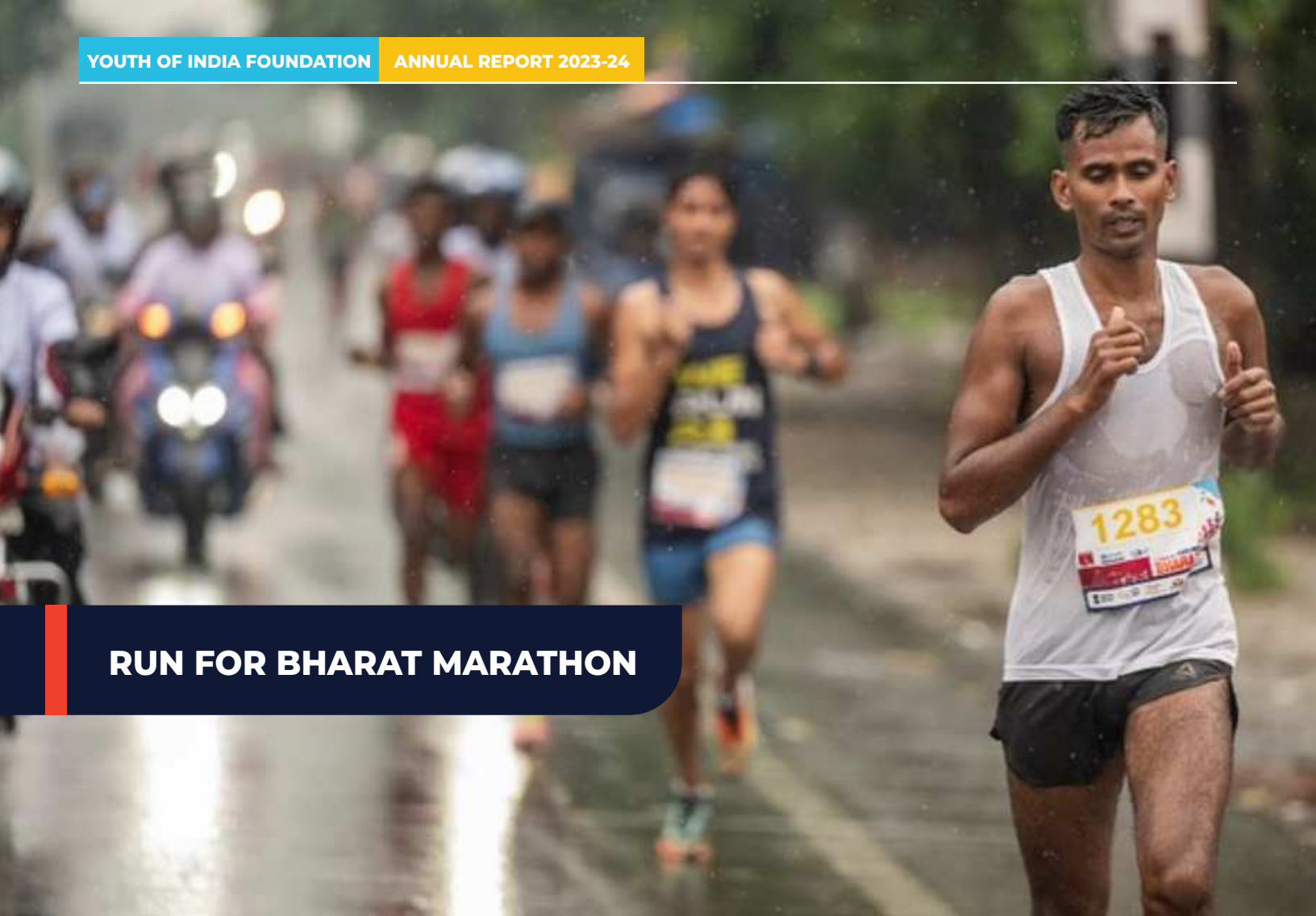

This gathering brought together professionals from the tea industry, offering a platform for rich conversations about entrepreneurship and the role of innovation in shaping the future of the tea industry.

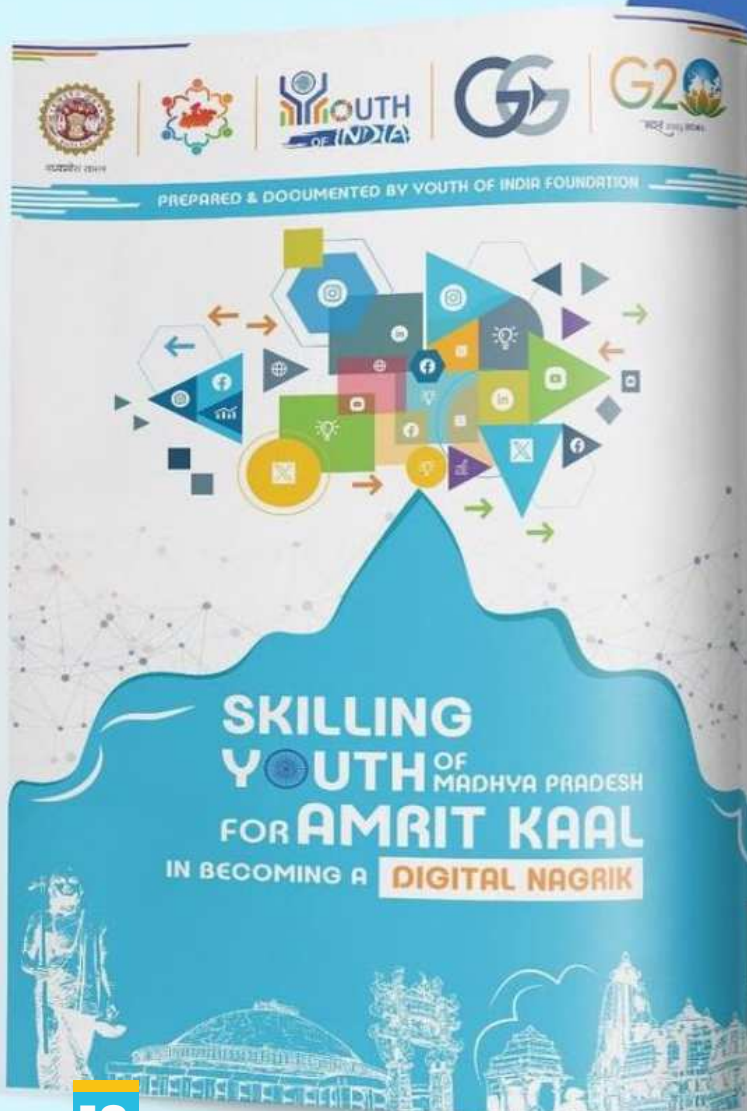

SOLAR BLAZER



JANGAON DISTRICT, TELANGANA, INDIA

SolarBlazer, a collaborative effort between Salesforce India and the Youth of India Foundation, is set to make a transformative impact in three villages—

1. Madikantigudam
2. Ustheppugudam
3. Ajmera Thanda

—in Jangaon district, Telangana.

Solar Blazer aims to liberate these communities from the constraints of unreliable energy, while also providing access to safe drinking water and more. By embracing clean, reliable, & renewable energy sources, SolarBlazer aligns with G20 Bharat's commitment and empowers India's youth to lead the charge towards a sustainable future.

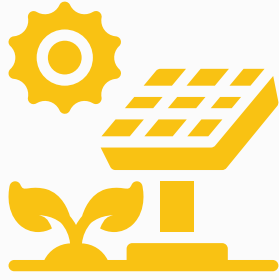
As we embarked on this journey towards a Brighter, Cleaner, and Greener Future, Solar Blazer stands as a beacon of hope and progress.

On our visit, we engaged in meaningful discussion with the local authorities to gather their insights. Through this interaction, we gained a deep understanding of the challenges faced by the villagers and explored the potential of addressing these issues through the implementation of solar power plants. The fact that the given three villages, namely Ajmera Thanda, Ustheppu Gudam Thanda, and Madikantigudam Thanda, fell under the tribal category, specifically the Banjara community, reassured our commitment to strengthening the tribal communities facing such challenges.

Furthermore, the Sarpanch happened to be a Tribal Woman too. Hence, we believed in the ardent need to empower tribal women through Green Skilling and Green Jobs, thereby reducing vulnerabilities and dependency on black electricity in the region.

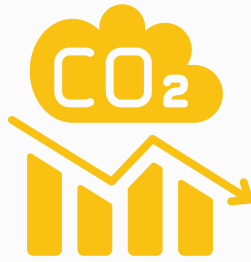
This would further only lead us to contribute to The 2030 Agenda of the United Nations (Sustainable Development Goals), namely Goal 1, Goal 3, Goal 4, Goal 5, Goal 6, Goal 7, Goal 8, Goal 10, Goal 13, Goal 16, and Goal 17. Possibly one of the very few projects by a grant through a CSO, which looked at localizing 11 out of 17 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals through ONE SINGLE PROJECT.

These villages shared a common struggle due to their weak financial condition and were severely affected by frequent power cuts, leading to water scarcity issues that ultimately affected their livelihoods. While some other Thandas also experienced similar problems, they were slightly more financially stable in comparison to these three Thandas.

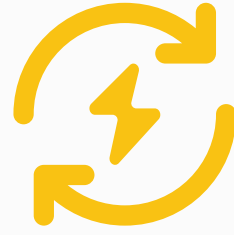

At Youth of India, we've made a significant impact by promoting inclusive education.

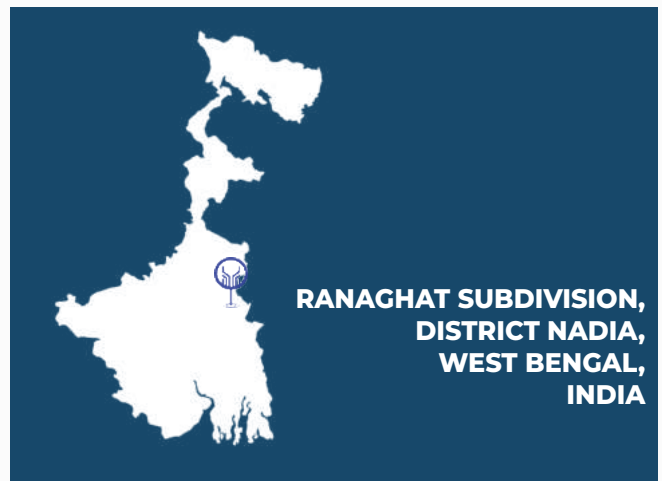

By offering continuous skill-building & training courses, we're empowering individuals to become responsible #DigitalNagrik and contribute to India's digital leadership.

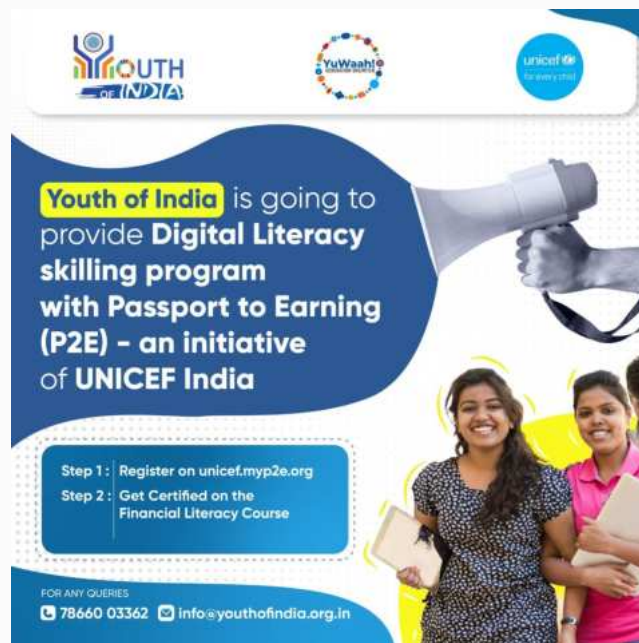

PASSPORT TO EARNING

Passport to Earning is the Digital Literacy skilling initiative by the Youth of India Foundation in collaboration with UNICEF and YuWaah tailored for women in Himachal Pradesh.

A total of 500 women from three districts have received digital education and training in financial matters through the P2E online learning system. This program has been implemented in the districts of Una, Bilaspur, and Ghumarwin.

The Youth of India Foundation Skilling Centre has been set up in four locations, connecting 12 villages in total. Each skill center accommodates an average of 30 students, aiming to enhance the academic and extracurricular abilities of children from tribal communities in these areas.

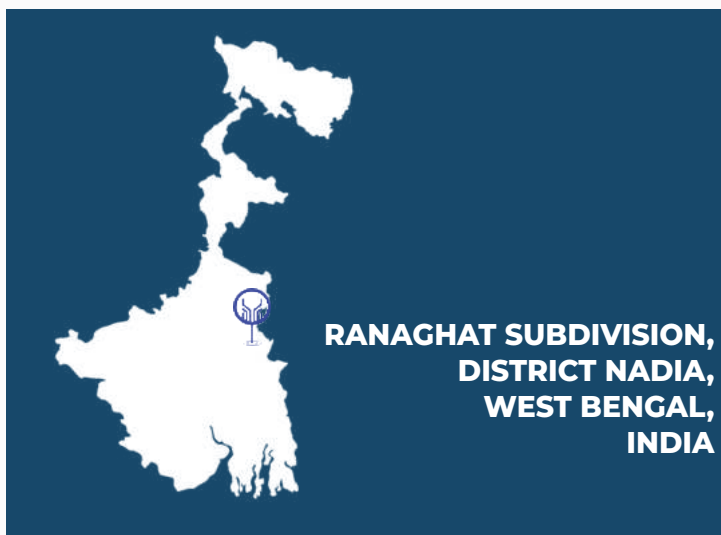

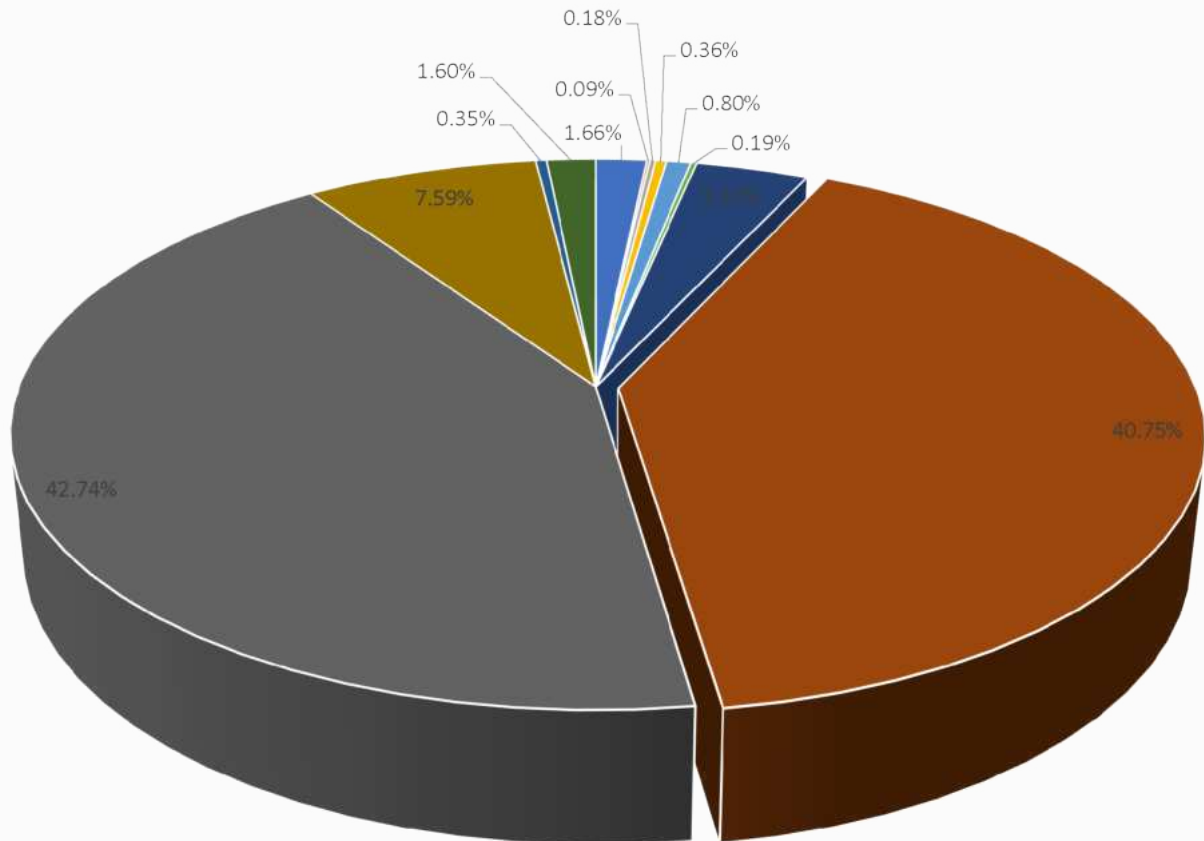
