Village Description:

- Oldest Village in Telangana
- Gangapuram village is located in Gollapalle mandal of Karimnagar district in Telangana, India¹
- It is situated 8km away from sub-district headquarter Gollapalle (Tehsildar office) and 61km away from district headquarter Karimnagar.

Socio-Economic Factors:

- Access to education and healthcare services varies, impacting residents' well-being.
- No Primary Health Care Centre
- 1 Gram Panchayat Office
- 2 Government Schools
- 2 Village Borewell
- 1 Post Office
- Basic infrastructure like water supply and transportation infrastructure is crucial for daily life.
- Source of Income: 90% Agriculture, rest involved in Dairy Farms, Bidi making.

- More Pakka houses in Peddapahad than Gangapuram.

Village Description:

- As part of Telangana Districts re-organisation, Obulakeshvapur Village Jangaon Mandal re-organised from Warangal District to **Jangaon District**³
- This place is in the border of the Warangal District and Nalgonda District. Nalgonda District Alair is South towards this place.
- Jangaon is the Nearest Town to Obulakeshvapur. Jangaon is 12 km from Obulakeshvapur. Road connectivity is there from Jangaon to Obulakeshvapur.
- 1500 years old Hanuman Temple is situated here.
- Children are involved in Cricket playing.

Socio-Economic Factors:

- Basic infrastructure such as electricity and water supply are available, though the quality and reliability can vary.
- There are primary and possibly secondary schools in or near the village. Higher education facilities may be further away.

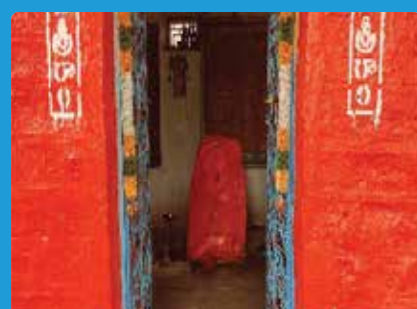

Village Description:

- Korra Thanda is surrounded by Devarakonda Mandal towards East, Madgul Mandal towards west, Nampally Mandal towards East, Gundlapally (Dindi) Mandal towards South.
- New born Village, mostly populated by ST communities.
