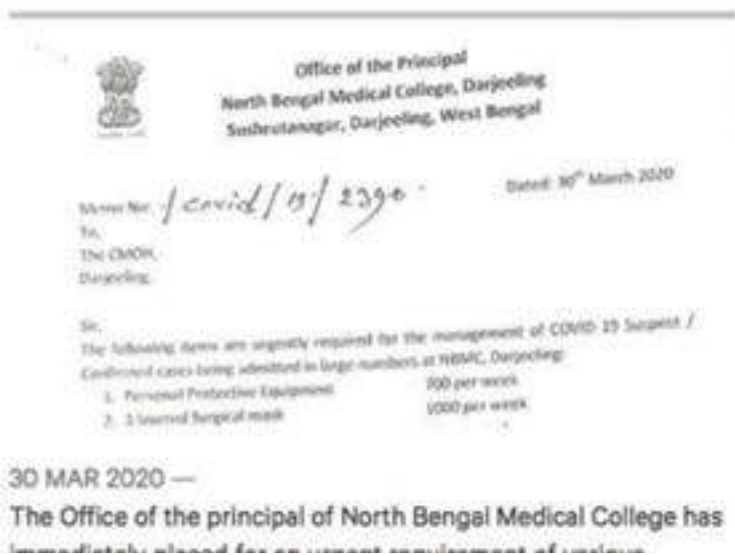

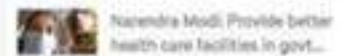

Dear friend,

I take this opportunity to thank your organisation for joining the Government of India in this battle against COVID-19 with commitment and dedication. At this critical juncture, it is necessary for us to take a whole-of-India approach. Stakeholders with immense expertise like you need to come together and channelize efforts to fight this threat together. Your tremendous experience and expertise in understanding the pulse at the grassroots will be of great help to our country now. There is nobody better placed than you to work closely with communities, spread awareness in the areas of prevention, protection, and fighting stigma. Your networks can do our nation a great service by preparing our communities, especially the rural population, in putting together the most efficient response mechanisms against this pandemic. I am positive that the capabilities, expertise and resources of your organisation will be a game-changer at this moment by complementing the State and Central Government systems. In these emergent times the fight against this pandemic cannot be fought without the active support and collaboration of your organisation.

The Government of India has constituted a Committee comprising of myself, Dr. Vijayaraghavan, PSA; Mr. Kamal Kishore, Member, NDMA; Mr. Sandeep Mohan Bhattacharya, Member, CBIC; Mr. Anil Malik, AS, MHA; Mr. Gopal Baglay, JS, PMO; Ms. Tina Saini, DS, Cabinet Secretary; Ms. Anshwarya Singh, DS, PMO.

We have greatly benefited from our preliminary discussions with some partners from Civil Society Organisations. Based on today's interactions, we strongly believe that CSOs have a pivotal role in joining forces with the local district and state administration in several critical areas. Also, CSOs working in a district must collaborate with each other so that there is no duplication of work and could themselves appoint one CSO as the nodal to coordinate with the District Administration.

A primary area where you may like to focus is the movement of migrant labourers. The Government has taken several measures so that their livelihoods are protected. At this juncture, I request you to coordinate your efforts and work closely with the district administrations and state governments so that measures of care, shelter, food and social distancing go hand in hand and they are fully taken care of in their present location. It is our responsibility that no one goes without shelter and food.

Some of the most important areas where the CSOs can aid and supplement the efforts of the State and local administration are:

1. To assist and support the local administration in setting up community kitchens particularly for migrants and homeless population working in urban areas.
2. To supplement the government efforts to provide shelter to homeless, daily wage workers, and urban poor families.
3. To create awareness about prevention, hygiene, social distancing, isolation, and combating stigma.
4. To extend support for distribution of PPE and protective provisions - sanitizers, soaps, masks, gloves etc. for community workers and volunteers.
5. To support the State governments and local administration in filling gaps in routine delivery of public health care, and promoting hygiene measures.
6. To assist the local administration in identifying hotspots and decontaminating and care given to deliver services to the elderly, persons with disabilities, children, transgender persons, and other vulnerable groups.
7. Partner with State and local governments in enlisting volunteers from among individuals and communities.
8. To develop communications strategy in different vernaculars whereby they become active partners in creating awareness at the community level so that COVID-19 spread is tightly controlled and false information fully countered.
9. To partner with State and local governments in promoting social and behaviour change.
10. By ensuring that there is no stigma and discrimination against COVID-19 patients. This would require extension and mass communication.

Our team in NTI Aayog is committed to working in close collaboration with CSOs working at the grassroots and with the vulnerable communities. I am optimistic that with your zeal and commitment, we will emerge victorious in the fight against COVID-19. I thank once again, your whole hearted participation in this critical nation building exercise, which has direct bearing on the social and economic fabric of our great country.

Dear friend,

As you may be aware, under the Pradhan Mantri Darshn Kalyan package more than 30 crore poor have been given financial assistance to the tune of Rs. 26,256 crore. This package consists of support to PHUDY women account holders, support to NSAP (aged widows, divorced, senior citizens), farmers under PM Kisan and support to building and construction workers. In addition to this sufficient funds are available under State Disaster Relief Fund (SDRF). As such sufficient funds have been made available in Districts for the poor people including migrant workers.

Yesterday I have written to all Chief Secretaries and District Collectors of all States / UTs (Copy enclosed at Annexure-I) to partner and associate with NGOs of their States and Districts to ensure that all the poor persons specially migrants, poor farmers, building and construction workers, aged widows, Divorced and senior citizens etc. do not suffer for want of food or shelter and no one in the country remains hungry.

In this connection I am enclosing a letter from Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution (Annexure-II) addressed to Chairman and Managing Director of Food Corporation of India to ensure that foodgrains would be supplied throughout the country at the uniform rate of Rs. 21 per kilogram for wheat and Rs. 22 per kilogram for Rice to all the charitable / non-Governmental organisations engaged in relief operations / running relief camps for migrant labourers / vulnerable groups (as mentioned above) due to the present lockdown conditions. It has also been directed vide this letter that there will be no upper limit for allocation of food grains to each such organisation from any FCI depot. Kindly utilise this facility.

Accordingly you are requested to immediately contact your District Collector / PCI Manager for obtaining food grains at the above mentioned rates so as to ensure that no one in the country remains hungry.

This is in continuation of DO letter from CEO, NTI Aayog vide letter dated 30-03-2020 (copy attached) addressed to all Civil Society Organisations (CSOs) registered on NGO Darpan Portal to actively contribute to address the problems of outbreak of COVID-19. CEO, NTI Aayog has also requested Chief Secretaries vide his DO Letter dated 31-03-2020 (copy attached) of all the States/UTs to advise District Collectors to mobilise all the CSOs at the field level with the request to:

- Designate a District level nodal officer to coordinate with local NGOs.
- The Nodal Officer should maintain a list of all credible NGOs, there are of functioning (health, education, child rights, etc.) and contact details of their heads;
- A Nodal / Mother NGO for each district, or groups of Districts should also be identified, for coordinating with the District Nodal Officer;
- The District Nodal Officer and Nodal / Mother NGO should identify areas (both sectoral and geographical) for the various NGOs in the District. Overlapping of areas and function in one area have to be fully avoided.
- It may also be considered if all NGOs can be advised to have common / uniform menus for food distribution.

2. Accordingly you are requested to contact concerned District Collectors to coordinate your efforts to fight against COVID-19.

लॉक डाउन में घर-घर खाद्य सामग्री पहुंचाने के लिए जनता डिलीवरी

● शहर के पांच युवाओं की सेवाभावी पहल

सिलीगुड़ी (संदीप कर्नाबी)। देश भर में 21 दिवसीय लॉक डाउन को लेकर समाज के हर उम्र और वर्ग के लोग सेवा भावी मुहूर्त के रूप में अग्रसर हुए। सभी ने अपने अपने अनुसार इस संकट की स्थिति में देश सेवा और समाज सेवा में अपना योगदान बनाने का मन बनाया।

जबका बस एक ही था कि इस घड़ी में अपनी और देश के लिए कुछ सकारात्मक योगदान करें। इसी कड़ी में सिलीगुड़ी शहर के पांच युवाओं ने शहरवासियों को सेवा देने के संकल्प के साथ ट्रोमरी समान के होम डिलीवरी के संकल्प के साथ जनता डिलीवरी नामक मुहिम को प्रारंभ किया।

लॉक डाउन और कोविड संक्रमण से बचने के लिए सोशल डिस्टेंसिंग अपनायत था और लोग घर से बाहर निकलना भी नहीं चाहते थे, इसी को ध्यान में रखकर इन युवाओं की टोली ने घर-घर खाद्य सामग्री पहुंचाने के लिए जनता डिलीवरी



नामक स्टार्टअप का शुभारंभ किया। सिलीगुड़ी डॉन खेती के स्कूल के पूर्व छात्र और वर्तमान में बंगाली में एक गैर सरकारी बैंक में कार्यरत 24 वर्षीय शिव कुमार शंखल की पहल पर उनके संग डॉन खेती के स्कूल के पूर्व छात्र 23 वर्षीय विशाल अग्रवाल, 20 वर्षीय लख्य अग्रवाल, 24 वर्षीय सौरभ पोषल

और 22 वर्षीय अर्जुन अग्रवाल ने साथ दिया और सेवा भावी घुमट जनता डिलीवरी की शीर्षक हुई। इस युवा टीम ने शहर के कई इलाकों के ट्रोमरी विक्रेताओं से संपर्क किया और अपनी योजना से जोड़ दिया। डिलीवरी के लिए शहर के कई डिलीवरी बॉय से टर्नअप किया गया। शिव कुमार शंखल ने

कहा कि लॉक डाउन के कारण घुमटे विक्रेता से काफ़ी पर आना पड़ा। यहाँ देखा कि ट्रोमरी स्टोर पर लोग भीड़ करते हुए जबरन का सामान खरीद रहे हैं और सोशल डिस्टेंसिंग का पालन नहीं कर रहे हैं, भूक स्टोर जमा भी माजबूरी था, क्योंकि शहर में होम डिलीवरी के गिने घुने ही विकल्प थे। हमने तुरंत सोचा कि क्यों न इस घात में लोगों को यह सेवा दी जाए और यही जन्म हुआ जनता डिलीवरी का।

हमारा इस मुहिम के पीछे कोई प्रॉफिट मोटिव नहीं था। बस सेवा में योगदान देना था। हमने स्टार्टअप नंबर के माध्यम से आर्डर लेना प्रारंभ किया और बिहार से आर्डर आता है, उसी इलाके के हमारे टर्नअप विक्रेता के माध्यम से आर्डर देने वाले के यहाँ सामान पहुंचा दिया जाता है।

हमारे डिलीवरी बॉय सभी सुरक्षित मानकों पर ध्यान भी रखते

हैं। हम केवल 3 हजार तक का आर्डर लेते हैं और प्रत्येक डिलीवरी का 50 रुपये का चार्ज लेते हैं, जो उस डिलीवरी बॉय का होता है। हमारा यह सेवा गैर जहाँ एक ओर कुछ डिलीवरी बॉय को इस लॉक डाउन में काम और कमाई का ऑप्शन दे रहा है, तो दूसरी ओर इनके के ट्रोमरी स्टोर को भी प्रमोट कर रहा है।

सभी आर्डर स्टार्टअप के माध्यम से आते हैं और उन्हें डिलीवरी से पहले उनको कुल खत्म कर दी जाती है। जनता डिलीवरी में कोविड खती है कि इसी दिन या दूसरे दिन तक डिलीवरी हो जाए। हमने कमाओरो रोकने के लिए ही अधिकतम 2000 रुपये का लिमिट रिया। टीम जनता डिलीवरी का कहना है कि इस मुहिम को लॉक डाउन तक ही जारी रखेंगे और पहले 5 दिनों में हमें 100 से ज्यादा आर्डर देकर लोगों में समर्थन दिया है।

COVID-19: Free milk for poor in Siliguri

SILIGURI, APRIL 11/--/ As the 21-day COVID-19 lockdown entered the third week, Youth of India Foundation (YIF) have started free distribution of milk and had stitched masks in pockets of Siliguri and Jalpaiguri. The initiative was taken for people residing in slums and poor people. Moreover, around 1,500 hand stitched masks were also distributed to them, said the members of the organisation. Secretary of YIF, Gurpreet Saluja said that they have initiated a portal along with 'Sarthak Siliguri' for people to donate in kind and not in cash in a bid to help the people who are in need of essential commodities during the lockdown. "We have distributed 1,000 litres of milk in the past three days in the slum of Siliguri and Jalpaiguri. Our motive is to reach out to the lower section of the society and kids who are deprived of a nutritious food," said Saluja. Meanwhile, highlighting on the guidelines of the ministry of health and family welfare on wearing a handmade masks, Saluja said that they have stitched the mask in three simple steps. "More than 30 youths have been dedicatedly working to stitch masks. We have stitched 1500 handmade mask made by the students and youths of Siliguri. The mask have been distributed to the people linked in delivering essential commodities such as fruit sellers, vegetable sellers and definitely for heroes who are protecting our lives like policemen and sanitizers," he added. The organisation have also started collecting two chapattis from each house in a bid to feed stray animals.

WAY FORWARD

AS RURAL ECONOMY IS NOT ONLY THE BACKBONE OF THE ECONOMY, BUT ALSO HAS THE POTENTIAL TO PRESERVE THE DIVERSE CULTURE OF THE REGION. THUS, YOUTH OF INDIA ALONG WITH OUR OTHER ONGOING PROJECTS, WOULD SPECIFICALLY WORK ON THE GIVEN ASPECTS:

Brief Introduction

Youth of India is a YOUTH-led movement, evolved from the vision and successful and innovative campaigns hosted by Youth of Siliguri, a city in West Bengal in India, since 2015. Nepal had undergone a destructive earthquake, which led to massive destruction. The students from Siliguri wanted to extend their support for the people in Nepal, being 50 km away, by giving back to society. Hence, a group of young people came together to bring a difference. Dejected by the lack of support from various institutions as a group of students and not as a registered entity. Thus, we initiated The Pocket Money Campaign, inviting students and young people to donate from their pocket money. The entire city then poured in for the support, where the young people contributed Rs.1,50,000 from their pockets with some letters stating, “Dear Sir/ Madam, I fought with my mommy to buy toffee for 2 rupees and here I am contributing for a better Nepal.” Thus, Youth of Siliguri - an inclusive platform for youth to make an impact in society was formed. We believe that every Indian is part of Youth of India; it is only that we have to reach out to them. Since then, Youth of Siliguri and then, Youth of India have had hosted various grassroots actions, national-level campaigns, dialogues, discussions and strengthened our efforts in localising the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Some of our initiatives include:

1. North Bengal: Opportunities & Challenges:

North Bengal is one of the most deprived regions in Indian state of West Bengal. North Bengal is culturally rich in its heritage and aesthetically beautiful, focused on nature-based Solutions. However, it is underutilised and unrecognised in its growth and expansion. Youth of India launched a conclave in the region to give it a new direction and roadmap towards connecting the various SDGs for the region. The conclave was a cross-cutting step of connecting the SDGs towards the development of the region and the state. The sub-themes of the conclave revolved around Goal Numbers 1 (No Poverty), 13 (Climate Action), 10 (Reduced Inequalities), 11 (Sustainable Cities and Communities), 6 (Clean Water and Sanitation and Industry), and 9 (Innovation and Infrastructure). The participants in the conclave also took the My World Survey. We also recognised ten grassroots activists who are working for the development of North Bengal.

2. Darjeeling Votes:

Darjeeling Votes is an initiative to bring about the voter awareness drive constituting the SDG 17, Partnership for the Goals) and strengthening the Not Too Young to Run campaign launched by the Secretary-General Envoy on Youth's office. We led a mass voter awareness drive in the constituency on an innovative, zero budget. The campaign was reached out to more than 300,000 young people and its purpose was to engage the young minds towards holding the member of parliament (MPs) contesting for elections accountable on their leadership towards implementing SDGs in their constituency.



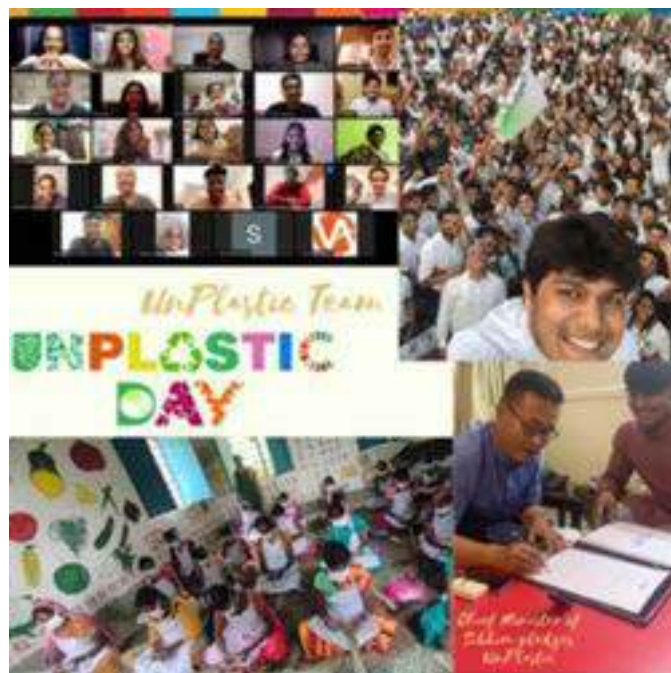

3. UnPlastic India:

UnPlastic India is an initiative by Youth of India Foundation in bringing about an awareness about eliminating the usage of single-use plastic, as envisioned by the Prime Minister of India in pledging to eliminate the single-use plastic from India by 2022. On 5 June 2019, UnPlastic India was launched by hosting the first-ever UnPlastic Ploggers Run in Siliguri in making UnPlastic Siliguri. UnPlastic India is working holistically in both bottom-up and top-down approach. At the grassroots level, in about **12 weeks now 50 institutions** including colleges, schools, hotels, cafes, shops, offices, companies have pledged to incrementally eliminate single-use plastic; **1 dairy farm** has successfully led the alternative for delivering milk in glass bottle than packaging in plastic; **18 Non-Governmental Organisations** have pledged to co-lead the movement in Siliguri. At the policy level, we suggested the Chief Minister of Sikkim in leading UnPlastic India; shared with the Honourable Prime Minister of India and the Lower House (Lok Sabha) Speaker in making the India's Parliament – UnPlastic incrementally by suggesting the alternatives and made some Member of Parliaments to advocate about UnPlastic. Our team is further committed to have 1 million young people pledge towards UnPlastic and suggest the government to pass a bill on UnPlastic.

4. Bending Curves:

Jagrati Yatra is a 15-day, 8000 km trip train journey around India that takes selected youth to meet role models who are developing unique solutions to India's developmental challenges. There are 17,000 applicants throughout India and other parts of the world and the top 450 are selected for the journey. The train stops at 12 locations to personally meet exceptional change-makers who are bending the curves of India and its society. Youth of India founder, Sailesh Singhal, had the opportunity to partake in the programme and was inspired by the participants (*yatris*) on board. He realised the urgent need of advocating the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) on a larger scale for everybody to achieve their targets by 2030. Initially, it is essential to create awareness about on the SDGs through a bottom-up approach and letting it trickle down into society approach to achieve the Post-2030 Development Agenda.

5. The Pocket Money Campaign:

The Pocket Money Campaign has been the fundraiser event for the rehabilitation of Nepal after the earthquake in 2015. The devastating earthquake has not only caused tremendous loss in Nepal, but has also brought about psychological trauma among the people staying in other parts of the world. The Pocket Money campaign, as the name suggests, is directly related to the pocket money of the individuals. In general, a youth gets INR 200 (approximately US\$3.00) per week to spend for hanging out with their friends, buying their luxurious wants, etc. The aim of this campaign is to create an impact among the youth to contribute a small but significant part of their pocket money for Nepal. The result? If 10,000 youngsters contribute even INR 10 (approximately US\$0.14) on an average, we are able to collect approximately US\$1,402. The Pocket Money Campaign was a zero-cost initiative with not a penny to spend on any of our works. The city for the first time saw a chain of 200 youngsters walking together for a social cause. We ran a two-day collection drive on the streets. The marginalised sections of the society, including the cobbler and mango seller, had been more generous towards their contribution. We saw small kids, who fight with their mothers for money to buy chocolates, putting a few coins from their bags. We received letters and messages from the youth telling their stories of the reason behind saving their pocket money. A letter from one individual, Rabindra Sarkar, read “I wanted my pocket money to buy many luxurious pens, but I will help Nepal to be a very beautiful country.” We opened all the 86 boxes in public, collecting a total amount of INR 150,000 (US\$2,061).

6. Share One, Plant One:

The United Nations Sustainable Development Goal Number 13 focuses on the need to take urgent action to combat climate change and to nullify its impacts through awareness-raising and human and institutional capacity on climate change mitigation, adaptation, impact reduction, and early warning. We learnt from the work of existing organisations that the maintenance of trees is more challenging than planting them. Thus, we wanted to share the message of “Share One, Plant One,” where distributed a plant, free of cost, and requested the recipient to plant an additional tree or plant in return for our favour. According to a survey of a small sample size conducted by our team in different parts of the city, we discovered that eight per cent of people will plant an additional tree apart from the given plant. Through our efforts we wished to create a behavioral change in people. There were more than 600 volunteers who joined us in campaigning. We hosted the city’s largest youth rally of 1,295 youngsters on the need to preserve the environment by creating a strong visual impact. During our peace rally, we utilised innovative handouts, placards, and flyers to spread the message on the need for conserving water. Nevertheless, the city saw the collaboration and dedication of the youth capacity distributing 100,001 *tulsi* (sacred basil) plants to the general population within merely seven days.

7. Gandhi Talks: Role of Gandhi in Rejuvenating Youth & Localising SDGs

It has been seventy years since Mahatma Gandhi departed from our midst, but his life and soul continue to animate humanity transcending national and international boundaries. His contribution to human development has been impactful to not be forgotten. The world today recognises him more as a compelling social innovator. Gandhi Talks revolves around his principles of non-violence, peace, justice, sustainable Living, and environment conversation by leading a life related to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Indeed, the SDGs are a tool to explicitly understand the life of Gandhi.

According to General Assembly resolution A/RES/61/271 of 15 June 2007, which established the International Day of Non-violence to commemorate, Gandhi's birthday, it is an occasion to "disseminate the message of non-violence, including through education and public awareness."

The journey of a boy to becoming “*Mahatma*” (great soul) is the message that is to be conveyed to youth, which aligns his life as a living message to implement the SDGs in one’s life through simple acts and measures. However, Gandhi has just not been instrumental by the life he led by example, but he has also been a catalyst for the betterment of society. Gandhi Talks focuses on the circumnavigation of these issues, which would be the first-ever talk series on Gandhi for the young people across the globe. Thus, SDGs in You is a framework to create an actionable roadmap for the young people to implement the values of the SDGs in one’s life and the idea of showcasing the *Role of Gandhi in Rejuvenating SDGs*. A series of dialogues were hosted throughout India to facilitate the discussion of the topic.



8. Mein Plasticwala (I am Plastic Person)

Mein Plasticwala is an initiative to start cleaning and making the people aware about the urgent need to preserve the river and the water bodies. The other theme is to engage the individuals by making them responsible and accountable for the plastic pollution in the water beds. As of now, for more than 25 weeks; our team has worked tirelessly in reaching out to 5,000 households in creating door-to-door awareness drives of conserving the Mahananda (river) in Siliguri - which is the major water source for more than 5,000,000 people. At the same time, we have cleaned about 1000 kilograms of plastic and waste out of the riverbeds. The continuous engagement of citizens at the grassroot participation in making our ocean tributary clean and taking them to further create a sensitization at one-to-one level; brings a two-way impact. Further, we propose to set up innovative solutions in keeping the river clean and healthy.



9. COVID-19 Digital Relief Efforts

It is to provide door-step delivery of ration and any other essentials during the lockdown period at free-of cost as volunteering in ensuring people do not face challenges while staying at home. It is specific to certain regions at present. We also give hand-made masks to beneficiaries so as to inspire them in stitching masks at home for people.
